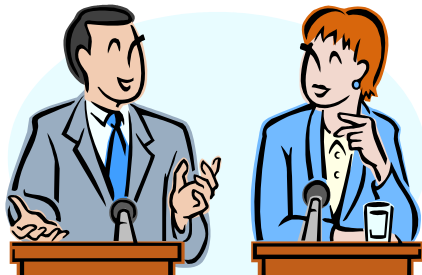

Novice/JV Session

Designed for first and second year students, Novice/JV Debaters, the three day camp is an excellent way to get introduced or reacquainted to the debate activity.

Students in the Novice/JV session can expect a low-key environment to get acquainted with the world of debate. For first year students, we will explore both types of debate (Lincoln-Douglas and Public Forum) and how they work. We will then go on to teach you the basics of debate and skills that are needed regardless of which type of debate you end up choosing. Second year students will focus on expanding the introductory skills that were learned last year and preparing for this year in JV or Varsity Debate.

The session is a three day session running from August 20st to the 22th.

In addition to the coaching staff, several of the varsity students will be on hand to offer support and help to those starting debate for the first time.
